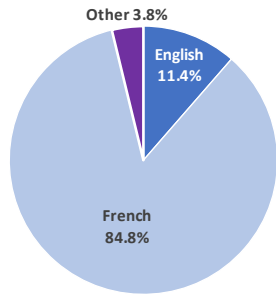


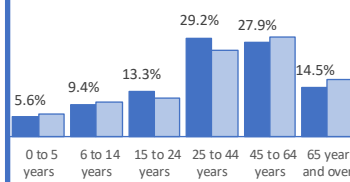

Children 0 to 5 by First Official Language



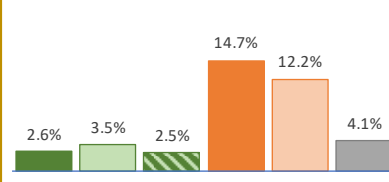

Population by Age Group

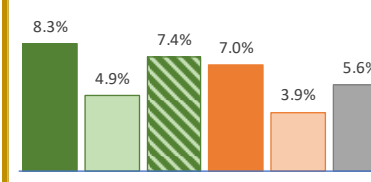


Parents with at Least One Child Aged 0 to 5

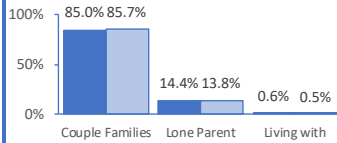
Parents Aged 15 to 24 Years



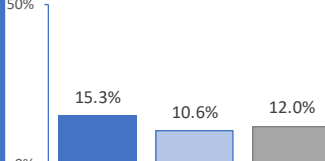

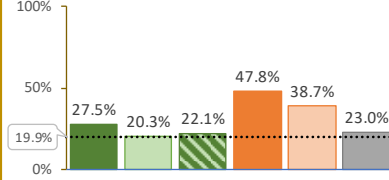
Household Living Arrangements of Children 0 to 5



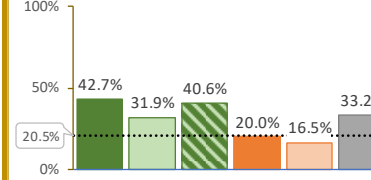

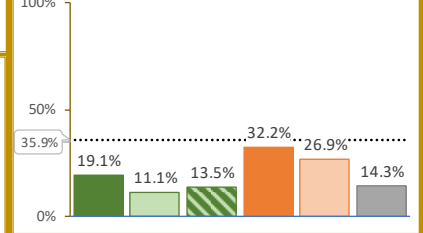

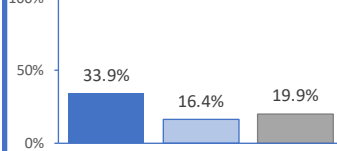

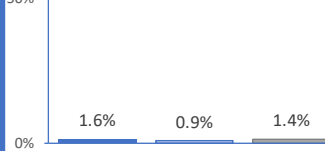

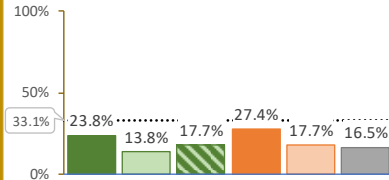

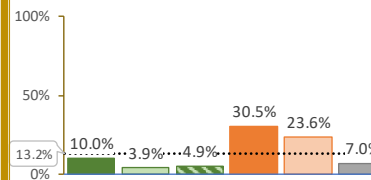

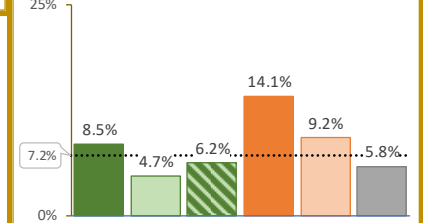

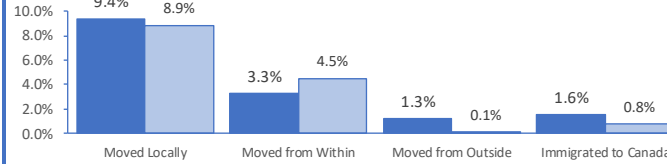

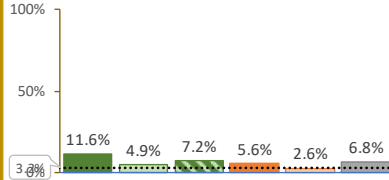

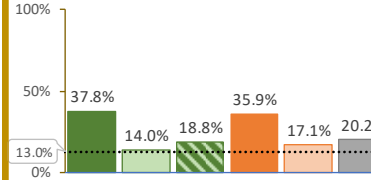
Recent Mobility (1 Year) Among Children 0 to 5



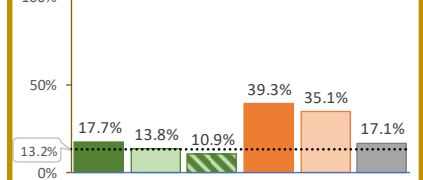
Recent Immigrants (2011-2016)
