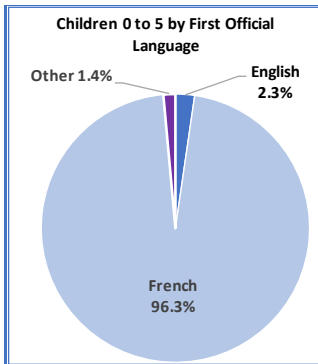
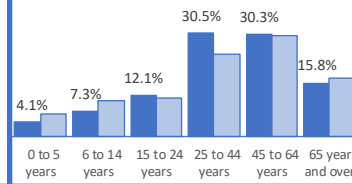

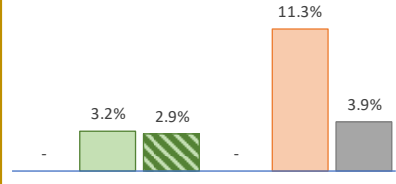

Population by Age Group

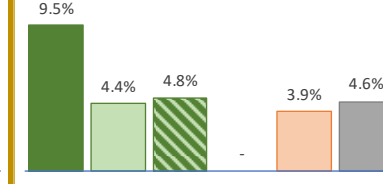


Parents with at Least One Child Aged 0 to 5

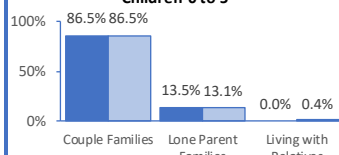
Parents Aged 15 to 24 Years



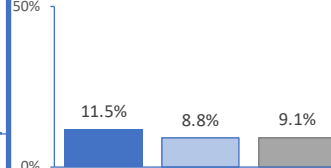

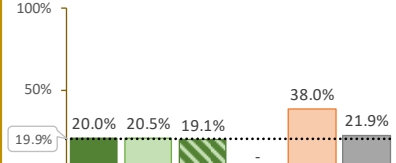

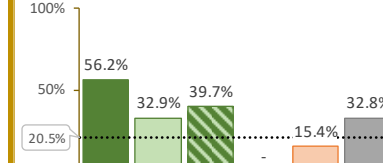

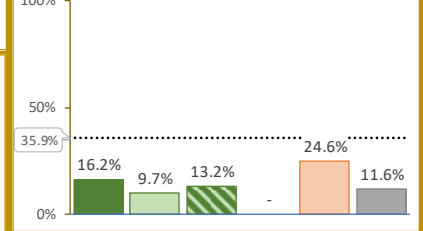

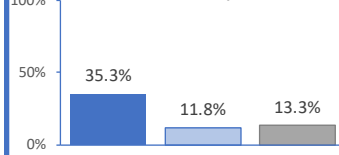

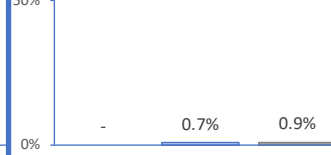

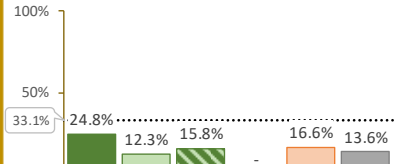

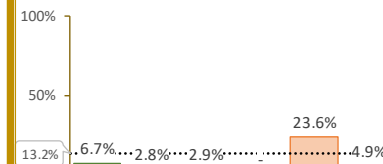

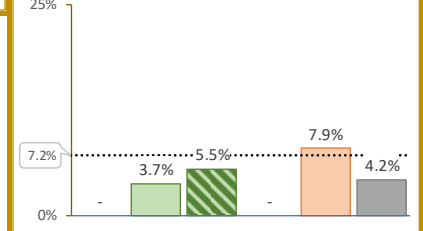

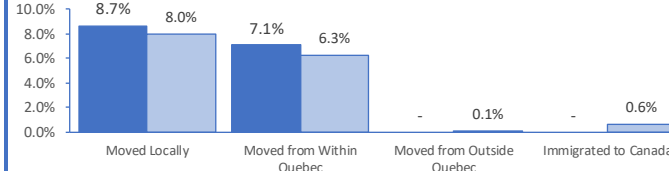

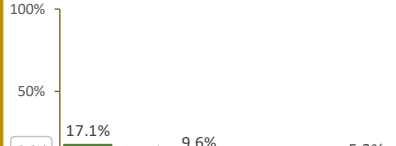

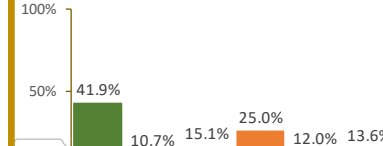
Recent Mobility (1 Year) Among Children 0 to 5
