

Quebec's English-speaking Populations According to the 2011 National Household Survey and the 2011 Census of Canada

This report presents tables on the size, proportion and age structure of the English-speaking populations of Quebec at various levels of health geographies. The information is drawn from two Statistics Canada surveys, namely, the 2011 National Household Survey (NHS) and the 2011 Census of Canada (Census).

This document is intended to:

- provide an easy reference point for information on population size, proportion and age structure
- clarify the variances in the population count and percentages that arise from the different sampling strategies of the Census and National Household Survey.

The report consists of two tables, namely:

- An overview of Quebec and the RSS regions, showing Census and NHS populations counts.
- A detailed table, showing Census and NHS population counts for CSSS and CLSC territories.

Two Surveys, Two Population Counts

The 2011 Census of Canada and the 2011 National Household Survey (NHS) both provide information on the Canadian population for various levels of geography and for numerous topics (e.g., demography, marital status, family and language) including characteristics associated with these topics. It should be noted that there are differences between the 2011 National Household Survey (NHS) and the 2011 Census when it comes to the tabulation of population numbers and percentages. The following notes explain the differences between the counts for the 2011 Census and for the 2011 National Household Survey.

The 2011 Census

Sampling Strategy

- The Census is mandatory for respondents.
- The target population for the 2011 Census includes usual residents in collective dwellings¹ and persons living abroad.

Content

- There are limited questions on the Census, namely, language², gender age and household structure.
- At this time, CHSSN researchers have 2011 Census language-based age structure and population count data available for Quebec's health and administrative geographies but do not have Census data for knowledge of official languages nor household structure.

¹ Person who lives in an institutional collective dwelling, such as a hospital, a nursing home or a jail. This includes residents under care or custody and employee residents and family members living with them, if any.

² There are 3 language questions asked of Census respondents: knowledge of official languages, mother tongue and home language. The First Official Language Spoken language concept is derived from the three Census languages questions which means that data for language groups is available at 100% sample levels throughout Canada.

2011 National Household Survey

Sampling Strategy

- The target population for the NHS does not include residents in collective dwellings and persons living abroad.
- The NHS is a voluntary survey and is subject to sampling error due to varying levels of response rate and was also subject to potentially higher non-response error than in the census.
- Given the limits to the NHS data mentioned above and due to the fact that cross-tabulations of small populations produce even smaller population counts which are unreliable for statistical analysis, NHS tallies are generally not produced for territories where the number of English speakers falls below 250 persons. Data for individual sub-items (ex. population living alone) is also suppressed when the count is less than 25.
- Wherever population counts are performed percentages may not always add up to 100% due to rounding.

Content

- The voluntary 2011 National Household Survey includes most of the content that was collected under the former long-form census, including socio-economic and socio-cultural data.
- At present, CHSSN researchers have access to one NHS dataset organized along health geographies. This dataset, obtained through the Department of Canadian Heritage (PCH), contains data on socio-economic characteristics (education levels, labour force status, income and LICO) as well as household living arrangements and recent mobility.³

Methodological Considerations

Language Concept

- There are numerous linguistic definitions that can be used to identify the language populations in Québec.
- The following tables were produced using the [First Official Language Spoken](#) (FOLS) definition with multiple responses proportionally distributed since it best reflects the total English-speaking health service users in the province.
- First Official Language Spoken is derived from three census questions: knowledge of official languages, mother tongue and home language. Dual responses are divided equally among English-speaking and French-speaking groups.

Geography - General

- Communities and populations can be represented in numerous ways with respect to geography. In addition to rural and urban groupings, are administrative territories for various sectors such as municipal and government services, health and social services, education and so on.

³ It is anticipated that additional datasets covering such topics as visible minority status will be acquired by the CHSSN in 2015.

- With respect to data on Quebec and its English-speaking populations, it is common to see data presented for Census subdivisions, Census Divisions and Administrative Regions.
- There are 17 Administrative Regions in Quebec which generally correspond to the health regions (RSS) mentioned below, with two important differences.
 - The Administrative Region 10 – Nord-du-Québec actually contains three health regions, namely RSS du Nord-du-Québec, du Nunavik et des Terres-Cries-de-la-Baie-James.
 - The administrative regions of Mauricie and Centre-du-Québec are merged into one health region, RSS de la Mauricie et du Centre-du-Québec.

Geography – Health and Social Services Sector

- To respond to the particular needs of the health and social services system and to the community organizations active in this sector, data is often available for the health geographies (Région socio-sanitaire, CSSS and CLSC).⁴
- The CSSSs outside the major urban areas (67 of 95 CSSS) have only one CLSC on their territory. In such cases, the CLSC data has been suppressed as it would yield no additional information.
- CSSS or CLSC territories with fewer than 250 English speakers in the NHS data have been suppressed as such low counts would reduce data reliability.

Layout of the Tables

Table 1

This table presents an overview for Quebec and the Régions socio-sanitaires of the age structure and population count data which are available through the Census and the National Household Survey.

Table 2

- The table presents data at the RSS, CSSS and CLSC health regions. It covers 8 pages with the first 4 being simply the numbers for each level of geography for English speakers in the various age groups.
- The final 4 pages show the difference between the population count and age group data for the two sources. Positive numbers indicate that the Census count is higher than the NHS count while negative numbers indicate that the NHS count is higher than the Census count.
- The RSS territories are shaded blue and CSSS and CLSC territories follow their RSS.
- When CLSC territories are listed, their parent CSSS is the preceding CSSS.

Data Source for the CHSSN *Baseline Data Report 2014*

The *Baseline Data Report (BDR)* series has used the Census of Canada over the years to provide researchers, policy makers, public institutions and community organizations serving Quebec’s minority language communities with a current and accurate evidence-base for their planning and decision-making. Changes in the design and implementation of the national survey of the Canadian population means for the first time CHSSN researchers were faced with accessing two different survey samples (NHS and Census) in producing the BDR. As mentioned above, the NHS is the only sample that provides data on socio-economic variables so the decision was made to use this survey for the 2014 report.

⁴ The CLSC territories are those of 2006.

This document is intended to supplement BDR 2014 by providing population and age group count using the 100% sample of the Census. It also provides a comparison of the findings of the two datasets (NHS and Census) for these two areas of concern so their differences are apparent.

It is recommended that users of the CHSSN evidence-base make reference to both sources of information on the English-speaking communities of Quebec.

- The Census provides the most accurate information on population count and age structure; the NHS provides the only information available on socio-economic and socio-cultural characteristics.
- The findings of the NHS should be understood to reflect the limitations of the sampling method used by Statistics Canada but is nonetheless the closest approximation available of the situation of the English-speaking population (or any population) with respect to certain characteristics.
