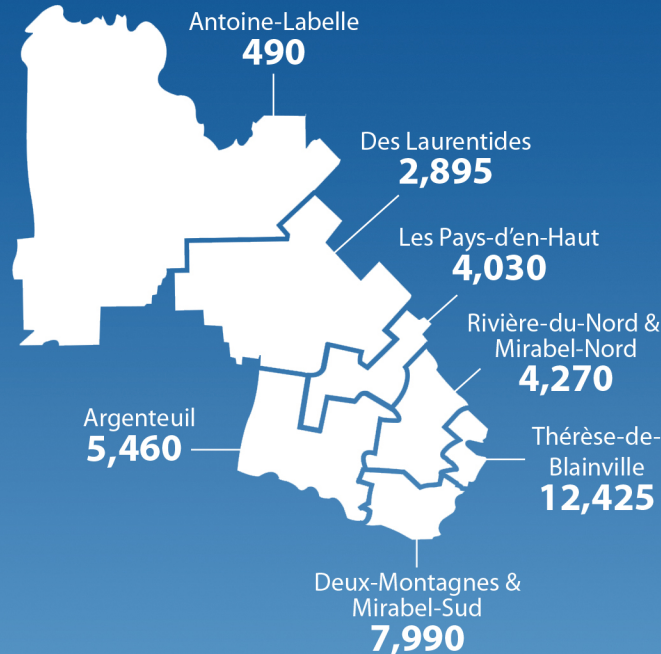
We currently have five committees:
