

Considering Patients' Experience

The overall perceptions and experiences of patients and their loved ones throughout their care trajectory.

These perceptions evolve at each point of contact, whether clinical or otherwise.





Adapting Information to Encourage Patient Participation

Examples of benefits:

Efficacy of care: better compliance with medication

Efficiency: better preparation for medical examinations (time of appointment, fasting, etc.)

Safety: better handling of hazardous medications

Continuity: better management of condition after returning

home

Profile of Our Patients (Literacy)

- Limited reading comprehension skills
- 48% of Canadians = reading skills around Secondary 1* student level
- Most susceptible populations: >65 years old, sick people, immigrants/First Nations


Minimizing the effort of reading
