

Main concerns about services not being available in English

Worried that the French community will not be as welcoming	56%	58%
Worried that their child will not be understood	51%	52%
Worried that they will not understand important information	46%	48%
Worried that their child will not understand what is being asked of them	39%	48%

Worried that they won't be able to participate because everything is in French	39%	35%
Worried that their child will fall behind in learning English	32%	18%
Worried that their child may not make friends with other English-speaking children	27%	18%






