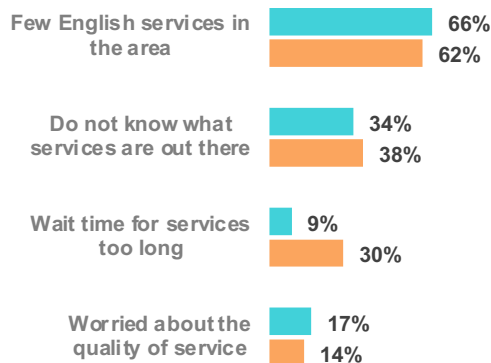

Worried that the French community will not be as welcoming	34%	58%
Worried that their child will not be understood	21%	52%
Worried that they will not understand important information	26%	48%
Worried that their child will not understand what is being asked of them	25%	48%
Worried that they will not be able to help because their French isn't strong enough	32%	40%
Worried that they won't be able to participate because everything is in French	21%	35%
Worried that their child will fall behind in learning English	34%	18%
Worried that their child may not make friends with other English-speaking children	32%	18%

SURVEY METHODOLOGY

Web survey advertised among CHSSN's network of partners as well as a social media marketing campaign.

Target group: Residents of Quebec, English-Speaking, 18 years or older, parents of children under 12 years of age

Data collection period: May 28th to June 30th, 2021

Total number of respondents (all regions): 1,737

Number of respondents, Mauricie - Centre-du-Québec: 53

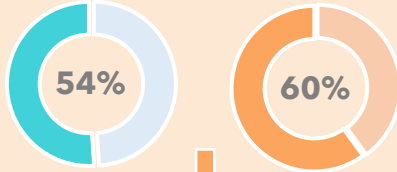

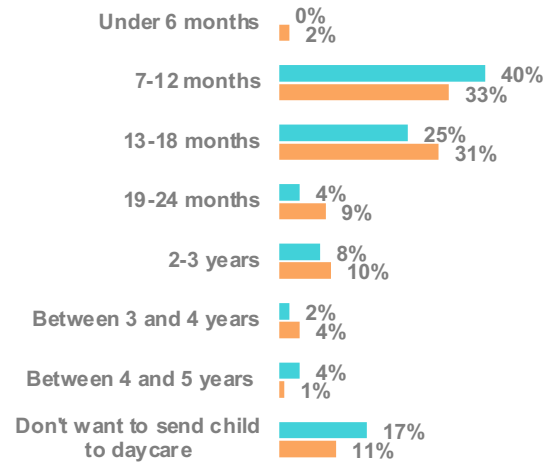

Preferred age to start daycare

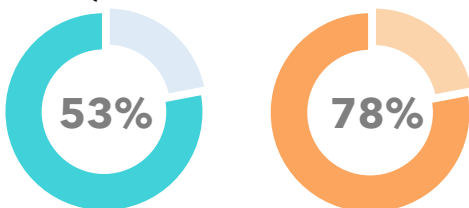
