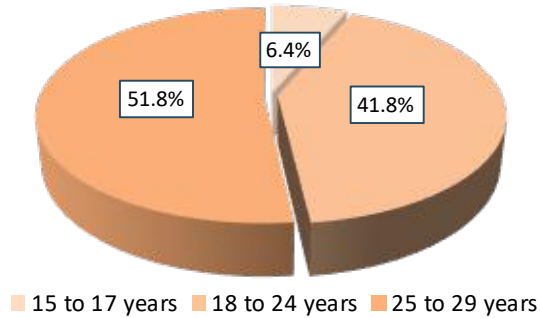

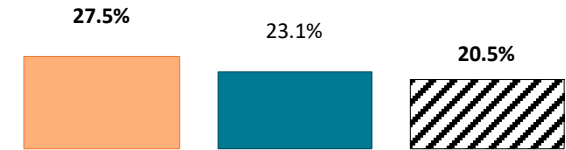
Distribution of English-speaking Population Aged 15-29 Years



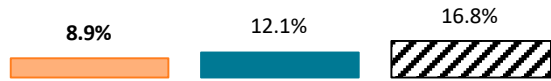

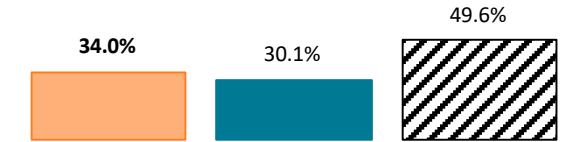
Proportion of the Population Aged 15 to 29



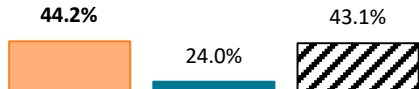
Lone Parent Family (15 to 29 years)



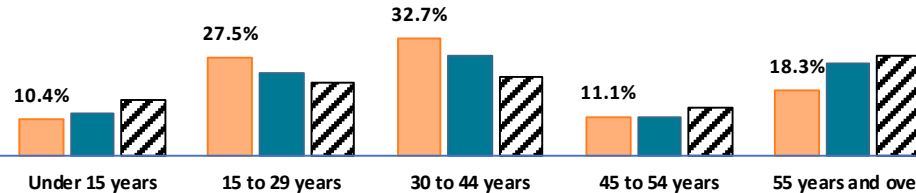
Low Education (15 to 29 years)



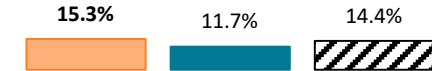
Visible Minority (15 to 29 years)



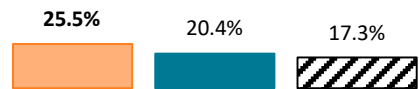
Age Structure



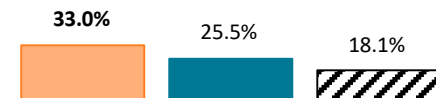
Unemployment (15 to 29 years)



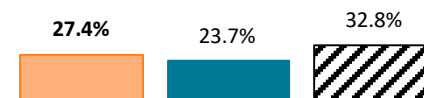
Recent Immigrants (15 to 29 years)



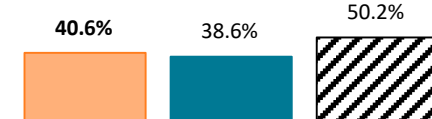
